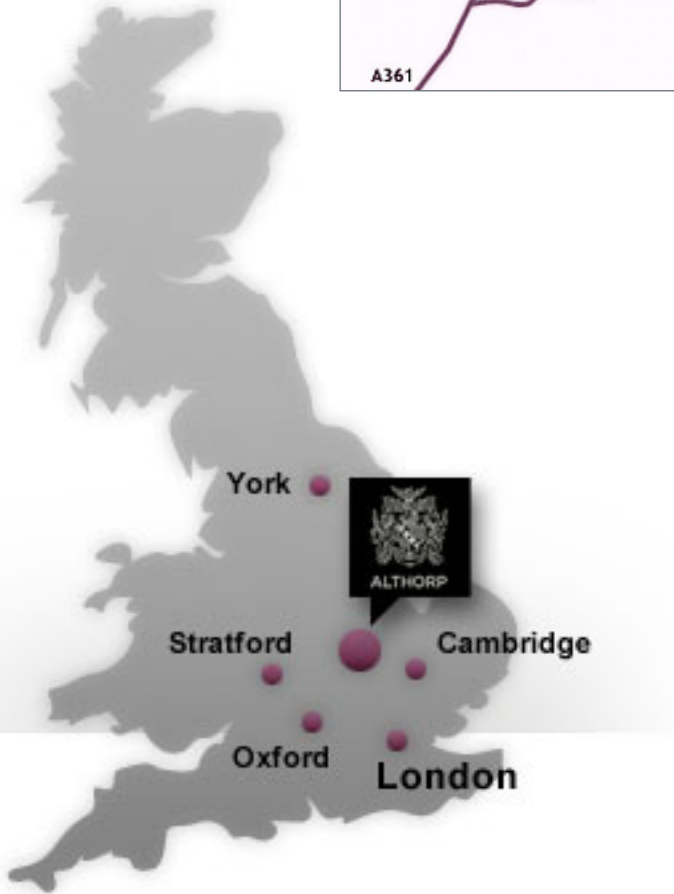

Parking Information

The Visitor Car Park is found at Althorp's West Gate. Car parking is free to all visitors. Cars are not permitted to use the Coach Entrance (East Gate) off the A428. Please follow the signs to the car park.



From the South

Althorp is clearly signed as you approach Northampton from Junction 16 of the M1.

From the North

Althorp can be approached from Junction 18 of the M1. Take the first left at the roundabout and follow signs to Northampton.

From the West

Althorp is signed from junction 1 of the A14 (west bound only). Follow A5199 to Chapel Brampton and turn off to Althorp.

For Private Functions

Please enter through the East Gate, signed as the Coach entrance. Enter postcode NN7 4HE into your satellite navigation system to find the East Gate.

Coaches

Coach parties are only admitted through prior arrangement. Information is provided when the booking is confirmed.

Public Transport

There are direct trains from London Euston to Northampton Train Station. Further details of train times and additional routes are available at www.nationalrail.co.uk. When you reach Northampton you will need to catch a taxi or a public bus to Althorp. Further details about local bus services can be obtained by telephoning Warwickshire Stage Coach on 01788 535555. The bus that runs to Althorp is service number 96 and departs from outside Northampton Train Station at 1050, 1250 and 1450hrs. Please inform the driver that you would like to get off at Althorp. Please note that buses do not run on Sundays.

Alternatively, taxis are available to tender from outside the train station. Althorp is around 7 miles away.
